Wrap Around Care

We are so pleased to confirm that we are able to offer a Wrap Around Care service on the High Street site from next September.

Breakfast club will be run between 7:45 and the start of the school day at a cost of just £2* (cereal and bagels available). *Subsidies will be available for families entitled to free school meals.

After school club will be run between 3:30 and 5:45 at a cost of just £5 (snack and drink included).

Our walking bus will ensure that children are transported between their Wrap Around Care and the building where they are learning.

We really do appreciate the need for this provision to support busy family lives, and we are delighted that we can offer this service.

Walking Bus

We have finalised plans for the Walking Bus that will transport children between the two sites. In the morning, the walking buses will leave from both the High Street and the Millbay site at 8:40 and arrive in time for registration at 8:55. In the afternoon, the walking buses will leave from both sites at 3:15 for arrival by 3:30. The walking bus service is free to use, but will need to be pre-booked.

Class Swap

Due to ongoing COVID restrictions, we are unable to go ahead with class swap in the form we had planned to. We realise the importance of ensuring that children are familiar with their new teacher and that they have an opportunity to find out about them and to share their own thoughts and feelings about the coming year. On Monday 19th July, all children at Millbay Primary and High Street will meet their teacher for next year and will meet each other; this will happen virtually of course, but we will ensure that they have time to work as a team and to ask any questions they may have. The teachers are planning some fun activities for the children to do and they will follow this work up on the return to school on 8th September.

Sports Day

The High Street children will have their sports day on Friday the 16th of July. At this time, all children will have the chance to complete in their class/bubbles in a Covid safe way. We were dismayed to hear the government announcement of continued restrictions, meaning that we are unable to invite parents to watch this event. We appreciate that this is disappointing, but the children's safety remains our key focus. We will ensure that we share images and videos of this event with you and do our best to make this a fantastic event for the children to participate in!
