Year 5 and Year 6 Swimming

This year the year 5 and 6 children will be taking part in an intensive swimming programme. Instead of going once a week, they will be going swimming every day for three weeks.

Swimming starts on Wednesday 6th September 2017 through until Friday 22nd September 2017. The sessions will be at the Life Centre.

School Day

The school day starts at 8:45 am, please can you ensure that all children arrive at school for this time.

The school day finishes at 3:15 pm.

Years 4/5 and 5/6 will leave school through the main school entrance, please can parents wait at the bottom of the carpark for their children to come out. Please do not wait in the pedestrian path as this causes problems for parents trying to leave with their children and prevents parents with pushchairs getting through.

Years 1, 2 and 3 children will need to be collected from their classroom doors in the phase 1 building.

Reception children will come into school and be collected from the side door of the nursery building which is located by the sheds to the right of the main nursery door.

For Nursery children, the normal entrance will be used.
