Kit List

Top Priority - Wellington Boots!

Please check that the boots fit comfortably with thick socks on before they go to the farm. They must be proper wellingtons with a tall calf section. The boots should be carried separately in a strong bin bag with the childs name on; we will use this again at the end of the week.

Clothes you will need:

- Several changes of clothes (not your best stuff) comfortable trousers e.g. tracksuit bottoms/trousers/thick leggings. The reality of life at Nethercott is that we don't wear a new outfit every day so no need for more than 4 of anything.
- 2/3 warm jumpers
- Waterproof Coat
- A pair of slippers
- Scarf/Hat
- Thick socks for wellingtons
- Daily changes of underwear/socks
- Pyjamas
- Dressing gown

Some extra things to bring:

- Spare bin liner
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Reading book

For Hygiene:

- 2 towels
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Flannel/soap
- Shampoo
- Hairbrush/comb

Please do not bring:

- Electrical or battery-powered items
- Extra food/sweets/gum

Please can children bring suitcases weighing no more than about 12kg. each or that are light enough for them to pick up and carry themselves. Suitcases will also need to be named.
