Start and End of Day

For children attending school, the arrangements are as follows:

8am – Breakfast club - pick up from the car gate

8.45am – Start for school aged children (reception – Y6) – pick up from the car gate

9am – Start for nursery children (can be 8.45am if dropped with older siblings) – foot gate

12pm – Nursery finishes – foot gate – drop off at car gate

3.15pm – End of day for school aged children

Please do not drop late or pick up early – it disrupts learning for the children and disturbs the rest of the class.

If we are unable to see the participant at the beginning of the session, we will have to unfortunately remove them from the chat for safety purposes. This information will be shared with anyone who registers prior to the session.
