



## Home Learning activities



Below is a table of possible activities that will help your child's learning and development.

<b>Writing</b> Can you write a letter to the Big Bad Wolf?	<b>Rhyming</b> How many words can you find that rhyme with 'red'? Can you write these down?	<b>Painting</b> Can you paint a picture of the big bad wolf? Which colours do you need?	<b>Number</b> Can you order numbers 1-10? Can you order numbers 10-20? Can you write your numbers in a number line?	<b>Measure</b> This week we have been measuring. Can you put your toys in height order- start with the shortest?
<b>Reading</b> See if you find a version of Little Red Riding Hood – can you use the pictures to retell the story?	<b>Reading</b> Listen to Little Red Riding Hood. <a href="http://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1-little-red-riding-hood/zfg2jhy">www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/english-ks1-little-red-riding-hood/zfg2jhy</a> Watch someone telling the story of Little Red Riding Hood There are video clips on you tube.	<b>Baking</b> Can you make a cake or a biscuit for Grandma? Write a list of ingredients you will need! What will you use to weigh them?	<b>Addition</b> Can you find ways to make 5 or 10? You can use objects at home to help add numbers together. $3+2=5$	<b>One more and one less</b> Get some raisins, grapes, cereal pieces. Place some on a plate. If the grown up with you says 'one more', add one more and say what number you have now. If they say 'one less', eat one and count how many you have left. Can you create a number sentence e.g. $8+1=9$
