### Daily tasks

- Read your reading book.
- Talk about what you have read.
- Write your name.

### Maths

- Go for a winter walk, can you count how many people are wearing a winter hat? You could keep a tally and write down how many you could see!
- Practise writing your numbers up to 20.
- Play some board games that need a dice with your family. This will help you practice counting on and recognising amounts. Snakes and ladders, Ludo and Frustration are great for this!

### Get creative!

- Create a stick puppet for the characters in the story 'The Three Little Pigs'.
- Draw a picture of someone dressed for cold winter day. Can you label the clothes they are wearing?
- Can you build a house made of straw, sticks or bricks? Use your stick puppets to tell the story!

### Explore

- Go on a winter walk and look around to see how things have changed from summer. How are things different? Is anything the same?
- Some animals live in cold places around the world. Draw an animal that lives in a cold place and find out an interesting fact about it.
- On winter mornings, you will find frost outside. Ask your parents to help you investigate what it is and where it comes from.
