A Word from Mrs Blake, Headteacher

To all our lovely families,

Another week of the summer term has passed and it has been a joy to see the children really engaged with their learning. Year six continue to do well with their swimming with around half the group now working on more advanced skills having met the 25m standard. The bus driver commented that our pupils were the most polite of all the children he transports – what lovely praise!

A few requests from me please – first please be considerate about your parking when dropping off and picking up. I have had complaints about parents parking on the pavement at the crossing point which means that children are forced to cross the road in an unsafe way. We will be working with the local highways officers and traffic authorities to ensure parents are supported in choosing safe places to park. Can I please also ask that if you wish to smoke which waiting for your children, please do so on the opposite side of the street well away from the school gates.

Finally, I am well aware that some of you are not receiving key information about the Federation with Millbay. Can I please ask that you check your spam folders for emails from the trust. If the emails are landing here, it is quite straightforward to 'unspam' them - I have included details of how to do this below. SPAM Emails

We all have different email providers but a quick search will tell you how to change an email from spam or junk to a trusted sender. Below is the guidance for doing this from Gmail accounts. If you have trouble finding out how to do this for your email account, please bring your phone with access to your account to school and we will help to do this for you.

Recover Messages from Spam

- 1. Find the message you want to move out of **Spam**
- 2. Open the message (or select the checkbox to the right of it)
- 3. Move the message to your Inbox or to a label: a. Move to your Inbox:

i. Click the Not spam button

ii. A black banner will display near the bottom of your window indicating the message has been unmarked as spam and moved to the Inbox

The conversation has been unmarked as spam and moved to the Inbox.

Absences

If your child is unwell and therefore not able to come to school, you will need to report your child's absence to the school office. There is an answer phone facility to leave a message by selecting option 2. **Any absences that are not reported will be marked as unauthorised**. If your child has too many unauthorised absences the Education Welfare Officer will pick up on this and will get involved.

If your child is late to school this is also marked on the register and the Education Welfare Officer also monitors this.

Medical appointments where possible should be made out of school hours. If you do need to take your child out of school for an appointment, we will require a letter/appointment card as evidence to allow us to mark this on the register.

Federation News
