We were delighted this week to receive our Ofsted report after our monitoring visit earlier this term. The report has been sent home this week – it is also on our website if you didn't receive a copy. Contained within the report are lot of positive comments about how well we have addressed the concerns from the 2019 inspection. Behaviour is much improved, the children's learning is much more purposeful and the staff are working together well to effect high expectations for all. I am very proud or the children and the staff for working so well to give such a good account of High Street ©.
