To all our lovely families,

It was lovely to see all of the children back at school this week. On Monday, the Y6 children started their three week course of swimming at the Life Centre. Miss Urquhart tells me that the children have really worked hard to do everything the instructors have asked and their behaviour has been exemplary. At the start of the week many children said they could not swim and they were not confident in water and, even after only five sessions, all children are happy to jump in and some will begin diving next week!

# **Federation News**

## **Parent Information Meetings**

Just before the half term break, Reach South held parent information meetings about the arrangements for our federation with Millbay Primary Academy. It was great to be able to articulate our plans for this federation and hear from parents regarding their thoughts, questions and concerns. One thing that we will be doing as a result of these meetings is to provide regular updates through this newsletter on all federation matters to ensure that you are as informed as soon as possible. Further to this, a letter will be coming out to you on Monday from Mr C.Toye which will address the issues raised in these meetings and will also include feedback regarding the survey about Wrap Around Care.

#### **Uniform Consultation**

One question raised during the parent information meetings focused on school uniform. As you know, the decision was made to maintain both the High Street and the Millbay uniforms. This decision was about maintaining the identity of both schools within the federation and reducing the need for parents to have to buy new uniform. There is however a particular discrepancy in Years five and six: at High Street, children wear polo shirts or shirts and school jumpers whereas at Millbay children wear shirts and ties, with blazers being introduced in Year six. We want to canvas opinion from both pupils and parents about whether to maintain the current uniforms entirely or to align the High Street and Millbay uniforms by not introducing ties and blazers at Millbay in Years five and six. A decision will be made by next Thursday to ensure that no parents worry unnecessarily about items of uniform that they may (or may not) need to buy over the summer.
