

ACCESSING GOOGLE CLASSROOM ON WINDOWS

As you know, all of your child's learning is now being set through a service called Google Classroom. We've made it as easy to access as possible, but here's a guide to walk you through how to log on to Google Classroom for the first time, on a Windows computer.

1. Log in to your Windows computer.




2. Go to Google.




3. Search Google for 'google classroom'.



4. Click on the top result.



5. In the middle of the page, click on 'Go to Classroom'.




6. Log in with your child's account details. (If you don't have these details, please give us a message on ClassDojo or phone the office!)

Your child's username is the first three letters of their first name, followed by the first three letters of their surname, and then @highstreetacademy.org.


For example, if my child was called John Cena, I would enter johcen@highstreetacademy.org

7. Enter your child's password. It will be something like 'bed | 3 bed | 3'.




8. Click 'Join' on your child's class, and then click on the name of your class to enter the classroom.







9. You'll then have access to your class stream (a bit like a Facebook news feed), where you can see your teachers' posts.



10. To view the learning that you have been set for today, click on the 'Classwork' tab. You can click on the subject to view the assignment, and view the attached slides and worksheets.




Your teacher may have directed you to upload work straight onto a Google worksheet. If that's the case, the assignment will look like this;




Click on the attachment to edit and enter your work.


Or, if there is no worksheet attached, your page will look like this;
